AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHINGUTHE $3-S$ IN PUBLIC SERVICE PROGRAM IN VALENZUELIO CITY AND PROVIDING FUNDS THEREFOR.

WHEREAS, as a major cegminercial and industrial center in Metres olanila, the City Government of Valentzuela is committed to ensure the delivery of basic services to the City,aspecifically in the areas of business vegistration and licensing procedure in valenzuela City;

WHEREAS, there is a need to continuoysly formulate program and initiatives that are efficient, accessible and easyuto implement, to make certain thatu aी business processes in the City go as smoothly as possible;

WHEREAS, thed Office of the City Mayor through athe issuances of Memorandum Nov 2011-006 which streamlined the Mayor's and/or Business Permits and Licenses Application as well as the implementation of the 3-5 in Public Service Program in all areas of business registration and licensing procedure in Valemzéela City;

WHEREAS, there is a negessity to formally institute the $3-5$ Pgogham which stands for, SIMPLE, SPEED and SERVICE, in order to make it assier for business registration and ligeasing procedure in Valenzuela City afid to further strengthen the delivery ofservices to the constituents on a longterm basis;

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ORDAINED \& as it is hereby ORDAINED by thent Sangguniang Panlungsod of Valenzuela city' in session duly assembled:

SECTION 1. TITLEE This Ordinance shall be knownsabd cited as the "Ordinance Establishinig the 3-S Public Service Programain Valenzuela City and Providing Fundsctherefor."

SECTION 2. SCOPE AND COVERAGE OF THIS ORDINANCE. This Ordimance shall cover all city governmenfe offered services which are relatednfo business registration, permits and Prensing procedure in Valenzuela city, such as but not limited to the following offices;

SECTION NO3. THE 3-5 IN PUBLIC SERVIGE PROGRAM. It is bereby formally instituted a program that offers a fast, efficient service that allows
 related application processes to ensune comfort and convenience of taxpapefs and guarantee high quality service tobe known as the $3-5$ in Public Segxiee Program in Valenzuela City.

The 3-S in Public Service in Valenzuela City shalNstand for:

## 1. 1. SIMPLE process;

2. SPEED in deliveryprocess and procedures; and
3. SERVICE excellence

4. $\mathrm{V}^{\text {I }}$ SIEPS IN DOING BUSINESS IN VALENZUELA CITY.

Before stafting any type of business in Valenzuela, a business license must be first secured, certifying that the operations and transactions are legal and legitimate?

After securing a business ligense, registrants are assumed to haga complied and will continue to complyawith all the Post-audit requiremegras Ant inspectigh shall be conducted within a month following the release, of ?the business license to ensure fül compliance. Any violation of conditions of approval is sufficiént ground for the revocation of the business license.

Do ${ }^{\text {c }}$ Mn consonance with the purposeofthe 35 Program, the initial requirgorents for any and all application in thegoffices mentioned in Section 2 heegat shall be simplified and limited.

The steps inodoing business in Valenzuela City skod comprise of the following:

1. Receiving - Submission of duly accemplished application form and mequirements with the concerned office;
$D^{\circ}$ 2. Assessment and Payment $R^{\circ}$ Application will be processed By the Evaluation Sector of the office then proceed to pay the Qratei of Payment issued at the Casifiler/Payment Division;

3. Releasing - Present Order of Payment for the issuance of permits and/or ricenses.

## SECTION 5. BUSINESS ONE STOP SHOP (BOSS)

 ensuting a rapiq froovvement of files or applications from oike unit to another cutting of the time lost due to movements. Further process floweharts are conspicuously placed at accessible areas inside the BOSS to guide applicants and taxpayers.DO SECTION
6. POST AUDIT INSPECTION. The main feature of this program is the post auditing scheme. Thiewarrants post inspection of the issuedqergulatory permits and clearances within reasonable time to double check to ${ }^{3}{ }^{3}$ owner's faithful confirmation to agy qegulatory measures and requikements. This includes sanitation permits, locational clearance and fire safety inspection permits. This is to ensure that the only compliant and first rate businesses subsists in the city.

Do C Further, Section 4 shall not in anycway be construed as a waiver of other documentary requirements enjoiged by applicable statutes and ordinargee

SECTION 7. APPROPRIATION. The City Governmenti, through the office of the City Maxpr, ${ }^{\text {t }}$, shall appropriate a reasonable aomount to be used in the implementation of this Ordinance, which shall be included in its general allocation.

SECTION 8. IMPLEMENTING GUIDELINES. Any implementing guidelinem through Executive Order issued by the City Mayor shall be prepared Bo? the effective implementation of this Ordinance. All issuances relatzive 9.0 the $3-5$ Program is hereby adopted, unless expressly revoked by the GitivMMayor.

SECTION N9. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE. If for any reason a part of this Ordinance is declared illegal or invalid, other patts or provisions hereof which are not affected thereby shall remain valid in full roirce and effect.
