TOURNAMENT RULES

Location/ Date : Kap. Larry's Pond, Coloong, Valenzuela City

March 31, 2012

General Tournament Information:

- Minimum fish length and maximum fish take are strictly enforced (see tournament rules below).
- Fish can only be taken by rod and reel, hook and line.
- Other methods such as Snagging (salvage), Electro Fishing (kuryente), Bow Fishing (pana or airgun), netting (lambat) and other methods are strictly not allowed.

TOURNAMENT RULES:

TYPE OF FISHING

- Bottom Fishing
- Float Fishing
- Lure Fishing

TARGET SPECIES

- Bangus and Tilapia (Main Catch)
- BidBid, Buan-Buan, Dalag, etc. (Secondary Catch)

PARTICIPANTS

- Anyone can join. No age limit.
- Maximum of 250 participants are allowed to join the tournament.

REGISTRATION

- Only registered anglers will be allowed to fish the area during the tournament.
- Registration can only be made thru the Sports Development Office and authorized Tackle Shops or onsite and is on a first come, first served basis.
- A registration fee of Php100.00 will be collected per participant in the individual category.
- Each participant will be given the following upon the registration:
 - A FREE T-shirt as tournament give away.
 - Two (2) Stickers/ Markers for his registered rod and reel.

FISHING GEAR

- Rod and Reel are required.
- Each angler is allowed to have a MAXIMUM of 2 Rods/Reels.
- A MAXIMUM of 3 hooks is allowed per fishing line.
 - (Each Angler may set up their gear (i.e. with lure, bottom fishing or with floater) in any way
- ANY ANGLER VIOLATING ANY OF THESE RULES WILL BE DISQUALIFIED.

OTHER EQUIPMENT

- Fishing stringer, fish basket or aerated fish container is allowed.
- The use of landing nets is allowed.

ILLEGAL METHODS

- Only rod and reel fishing is allowed. Other methods, whether accidental or on purpose, such as Snagging (Salvage), Electro-Fishing (Kuryente), Bow Fishing (Pana or Airgun), Netting (Lambat) and other methods are strictly not allowed.
- Any fish caught by any of the above illegal methods must be released and will not be scored.
- Snagging involves hooking the fish in any part of its body aside from its mouth.
- Electro-Fishing involves using electricity to stun and catch the fish.
- Bow Fishing involves the use of an arrow-like object to catch the fish.
- Netting involves the use of nets (except landing nets) to catch the fish.

ANGLING SPOTS (Option 1)

- All anglers required to fish from the blank (pilapil) of the designated venue. The use of a boat is not allowed.
- Angling spots are on a first come first served basis.
- Upon registration, the angler can choose his desired spot.
- The participant can transfer to another spot as long as it is not occupied by another angler.
- ANY ANGLER VIOLATING ANY OF THESE RULES WILL BE DISQUALIFIED.

ANGLING SPOTS (Option 2)

- All anglers are required to fish from the blank (pilapil) of the designated venue. The use of a boat is not allowed.
- The pond's shoreline is subdivided and marked with alphanumeric tags.
- Each tag corresponds to an angling spot.
- Each angling spot boundaries are clearly marked with small flags spiked to the ground.
- Each angling spot has been measured to give the optimum space for the angler to cast, fight a hooked fish and eliminate line tangles.
- Each angling spot will have a ticket with the corresponding alphanumeric tag number that
 will be raffled during the angler's check-in in the morning and again before the start of the
 afternoon session.
- Anglers are not allowed to:
 - Exchange drawn ticket with another angler.
 - Move the angling spot alphanumeric tag and spiked flag boundaries.
 - Encroach another angler's spot, unless it's necessary when fighting a hooked fish.
 - In case of line tangles, the angler without a hooked fish will give way and will cut his line if necessary.
- ANY ANGLER VIOLATING ANY OF THESE RULES WILL BE DISQUALIFIED.

SIZE LIMITS

- Minimum Size Limit:
 - Any fish less than 6 inches in length must be released and will not be scored.
 - ANY ANGLER VIOLATING ANY OF THESE RULES WILL BE DISQUALIFIED.
- Maximum Size Limit:
 - There is NO maximum size limit.
- Maximum fish take:
 - The total number of fish that may be taken by an angler in this tournament is 10 fish in any combination.

NOTE: The enforcement of minimum size length and maximum number of fish take increases the level of competition. It's up to the angler to strategize on what type of fish he wants to keep and at what size to achieve the highest possible score. The use of stringers or aerated fish containers to keep the fish alive is required in case the angler decides to return a fish for another one with a higher point score.

WEIGHING IN OF CATCHES

- Only legal catches (based on the tournament rules discussed above) will be weighed in.
- The fish must be surrendered **AS SOON AS POSSIBLE** to an Authorized Tournament Organizer.
- Catches will only be weighed on or before 2:00 PM (to be discussed further).
- After weighing, the participant will be given a receipt, as proof of the official weight of the fish and time of catching.
- ANY ANGLER VIOLATING ANY OF THESE RULES WILL BE DISQUALIFIED.
